

White House without a plan to address debt ceiling

WASHINGTON (AP) — The White House lacks a unified plan to increase the government's borrowing cap as a likely September deadline is drawing near, said Mick Mulvaney, director of the Office of Management and Budget.

A failure by Congress to raise the debt ceiling could send dangerous shockwaves through the global economy. The federal government could be at risk of defaulting on obligations such as interest payments on bonds as well as temporarily halting benefit programs.

The White House budget director suggested in an interview Thursday with reporters that neither the Trump administration nor Capitol Hill lawmakers have set their terms for an agreement.

"It's fair to say we haven't settled on a final way to address the debt ceiling any more than the Hill has," Mulvaney said.

The former South Carolina congressman added that none of this was necessarily "unusual."

Under the current borrowing restrictions, the government has already been taking extraordinary measures and will likely be unable to pay its bills at some point in

September. But Congress still has a recess scheduled in August that could create time pressures. Private analysts say the debt ceiling deadline could be extended into October.

Mulvaney said he would like to see the debt ceiling raised in July.

But Trump administration officials still have yet to resolve internal differences on the best strategy to increase the legal cap on government debt, which already exceeds \$19.8 trillion.

Mulvaney suggested he would like to have any increase in the borrowing authority be attached to other spending changes, a move that could attract Republican support but alienate Senate Democrats. President Donald Trump's budget proposal seeks to beef up spending on the military and border security while cutting many social programs.

Treasury Secretary Steve Mnuchin has indicated he would like a "clean" bill to raise the debt ceiling, so it would not have to be tied to any spending changes, but Capitol Hill conservatives are resisting the idea.

"Secretary Mnuchin believes it needs to be clean. I think the vast majority of the Republican conferences would not agree,"

said Rep. Mark Meadows R-N.C., chairman of the Freedom Caucus, a group of strongly conservative House Republicans.

Mulvaney said Mnuchin would ultimately be in charge of handling the debt ceiling push "once we do settle on our formal policy, if we do."

A 2011 standoff between Republicans and the Obama administration over the debt ceiling led to tighter controls on spending. That standoff was not resolved until the 11th hour and prompted Standard & Poor's to impose the first-ever downgrade to the country's credit rating.

The administration is also engaged in talks with House and Senate Republican leaders about what kind of increase they could possibly pass. Mulvaney said the issue was not a source of division inside the White House or the Republican Party.

The discussions involve whether the House should increase the debt limit enough to last through the 2018 election or the president's first term.

"It would be foolish of us to come up with a policy devoid of having talked to the Hill," Mulvaney said.

Congress also faces pressure to pass a budget in September for next

fiscal year, as well as to address administration priorities that include a tax code rewrite and the proposed repeal of President Barack Obama's 2010 health insurance law.

Failure to pass spending bills could cause a government shutdown and cause non-essential government agencies to close their doors. Trump suggested on Twitter last month that he might welcome a shutdown to help shake up the government.

Mnuchin told the Senate Budget Committee this week that "at times there could be a good shutdown," though he cautioned it's not the administration's "primary objective."

With action on the budget front otherwise stalled, the House Appropriations Committee on Thursday approved the first of 12 spending bills, an \$89 billion measure that contains generous increases for veterans' programs and Pentagon construction projects.

But the White House and its GOP allies — much less opposition Democrats — haven't come up with an overall plan for implementing Trump's promises to increase the Pentagon budget and advance more than \$500 billion worth of annual domestic agency spending bills.

Nike to slash 1,400 jobs, cut sneaker styles in shakeup

NEW YORK (AP) — Nike wants to be more nimble on its feet.

The sneaker maker said Thursday that it plans to focus on the hottest-selling sneakers, slash the number of styles it offers and sell more shoes directly to customers online as part of a restructuring in which it also will cut about 1,400 jobs.

Nike said the moves will help it offer products to customers faster as it is facing increasing competition from smaller brands and premium labels. Another problem: The running and basketball shoes Nike is famous for may be outdated.

More people are choosing fashion over function, with sales of classic sneakers industry-wide climbing 26 percent last year, according to research from The NPD Group. Meanwhile, sales of running performance sneakers were flat and sales of basketball performance

sneakers dropped, according to the same report.

"Nike missed the fashion shift away from performance basketball to retro," said Matt Powell, the sports industry analyst at NPD. "They still have not caught up."

Adidas, whose casual Stan Smith shoes have become popular again, has made a push to increase sales in the U.S. The German company said last month that first-quarter revenue in North America jumped 31 percent from a year before. And on the high end, Neiman Marcus noted to investors last week that sneakers, with an average retail price of \$360 per pair, have become a significant business as shoppers focus on a more casual lifestyle.

"The increase in speed of innovation and delivery is a direct response to the expectations of today's consumers," analysts at Susquehanna Financial Group said in a note about Nike's

moves.

Nike, known for its swoosh logo, will also make its sneaker-selling apps available in more countries at a time when online sales mean many big retailers and department stores are closing stores.

"We're getting even more aggressive in the digital marketplace," said CEO Mark Parker.

Nike said a main focus will be the 12 key cities in 10 countries that it expects to represent more than 80 percent of its projected growth through 2020. Those cities are New York, Los Angeles, London, Paris, Milan, Mexico City, Tokyo, Seoul, Shanghai and Beijing.

"It appears to us that everything Nike is working on is a brand-first story. If the initiatives don't help the Nike brand, they do not happen," the Susquehanna analysts said.

They said customers will barely notice the decrease in styles given the breadth of

options Nike offers.

But the shake-up, announced two weeks before Nike releases its financial results for the most recent quarter, seemed to make investors nervous. Its stock fell 3 percent to \$52.90 on Thursday.

Christopher Svezia, a footwear and apparel analyst at Wedbush, said that when companies announce jobs cuts and restructuring ahead of earnings reports, it doesn't typically bode well for how business is going. "We'll learn more in two weeks," he said.

Nike Inc., which is based in Beaverton, Oregon, said the layoffs represent about 2 percent of its 70,000 employees around the world. It declined to provide additional details about the cuts. The Susquehanna analysts said they believed the jobs cuts are likely eliminating redundant back-office positions as a result of a consolidation of reporting segments.

Uncertainty as Nevada aims to launch recreational pot soon

RENO, Nev. (AP) — Nevada voters legalized recreational marijuana in November, and officials are trying to put rules in place to start selling it on July 1.

It would be the shortest turnaround from legalization to the launch of sales in any of the other seven states and District of Columbia where recreational pot is legal. Regulations are complicated and typically lengthy to enact around a drug still banned by the U.S. government.

But Nevada's quick timeline faces a major hurdle: A legal battle between the state and the powerful liquor lobby over who can distribute the drug to retailers.

Here's a look at the obstacles to recreational pot in Nevada and what could happen next:

WHAT'S THE RUSH?

Anticipating customer demand, the state hopes to get a head-start on collecting millions of dollars in tax revenue devoted to education. Pot sales are required to start by Jan. 1, 2018, and are expected to bring in at least \$120 million over two years.

The Nevada Cannabis Coalition estimates an additional \$3 million a month if sales start in a little more than two weeks. Oregon and Colorado each raised about \$3.5 million in tax revenue in the first month of their recreational sales.

Nevada's expedited effort is in stark contrast to its handling of medical marijuana, which went on sale in 2015 — 15 years after voters legalized it.

WILL RECREATIONAL POT BE SOLD JULY 1?

It's not clear. The state said it intends to issue licenses so users can start buying marijuana buds, concentrate and edibles at as many as 60 existing medical marijuana dispensaries on that date.

When sales happen, anyone 21 or older can buy up to an ounce of pot but can only smoke or consume it in their homes. But the courts will decide what happens next.

WHY ARE THE COURTS INVOLVED?

A group of alcohol distributors and state-regulated medical marijuana dealers are fighting over who should be licensed to distribute marijuana from growers to retailers. The liquor lobby sued, saying the state didn't give it the first shot at distribution licenses as the law calls for, the only legal pot state with that arrangement.

The state Department of Taxation wants to license some existing medical marijuana cultivators and retailers to serve as their own distributors temporarily, saying there was not enough

interest among alcohol distributors to do the work. The liquor distributors denied that, and a judge temporarily sided with them and blocked licenses from being issued.

The judge this week refused Nevada's request to dismiss the lawsuit and left the order in place until he makes a permanent ruling following a hearing Monday.

WHY IS THE LIQUOR INDUSTRY GETTING INTO MARIJUANA?

The law says "marijuana should be regulated in a manner similar to alcohol." The political action committee promoting the measure was even named Regulate Marijuana Like Alcohol.

Pot rules are patterned after the system regulating alcohol sales, with separate licenses for wholesalers, distributors and retailers. Granting licensed liquor distributors first dibs at pot distribution licenses was seen by the state as a way to ensure the integrity of the system because they have already undergone extensive background checks and established a record of doing business with the state.

HOW DOES IT WORK IN OTHER STATES?

Like Nevada, Colorado and Oregon initially granted

recreational retail licenses only to existing medical marijuana businesses but now provides them to any qualifying applicant.

Maine and Massachusetts give existing medical marijuana facilities a priority for recreational licensing. Colorado bars people from holding both alcohol and marijuana licenses.

Washington state didn't have a medical program before legalizing recreational marijuana and now requires all pot business to be licensed by its state Liquor Control Board.

WHAT'S NEXT?

If Carson City District Judge James Wilson rules against the liquor distributors, licenses will be issued to existing medical marijuana facilities to transport products to retail stores in time for sales to begin July 1.

Otherwise, it's complicated. Wilson could order the state to exclusively license liquor distributors, but that could still mean at least some sales starting in two weeks.

He also could strike down the regulation itself. That would restart the whole rule-making process, which could take months. There's also the possibility the loser would appeal, prolonging the uncertainty indefinitely.

Agencies slow methane rules opposed by oil, gas industry

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Trump administration is delaying two Obama-era regulations aimed at restricting harmful methane emissions from oil and gas production.

The Environmental Protection Agency said it is seeking a two-year delay for oil and gas companies to follow a new rule requiring them to monitor and reduce methane leaks from their facilities. The delay follows a 90-day pause ordered earlier this year.

EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt said the agency is reconsidering the 2016 rule, which he said may duplicate state rules that can achieve equivalent or better results in reducing methane emissions.

Meanwhile, the Interior Department is indefinitely postponing a separate

regulation intended to reduce the amount of heat-trapping methane released into the atmosphere from oil and gas wells on federal lands.

A bid to overturn the rule failed unexpectedly in the Republican-led Senate last month, prompting Interior officials to promise to suspend, revise or rescind the rule.

Katharine MacGregor, acting assistant Interior secretary for land and minerals, said the methane rule imposes a "significant regulatory burden that encumbers American energy production, economic growth and job creation."

The Obama-era rule, finalized in November, "is expected to have real and harmful impacts on onshore energy development and

could impact state and local jobs and revenue," MacGregor said, adding that states such as North Dakota, Colorado and New Mexico "could be hit the hardest."

Kathleen Sgamma, president of the Western Energy Alliance, a trade association representing more than 300 companies, praised the twin moves on methane. The alliance and other oil industry groups challenged the methane regulations in court.

"Both rules vastly exceeded federal authority," Sgamma said in a statement. "The Trump administration is correcting that overreach from the prior administration, thereby saving jobs and supporting American energy independence."

Even though the two rules are delayed, "industry

will continue to increase methane capture rates as it has for the past three decades" through better technology and improved drilling techniques, she said.

Delaying the standards will increase smog and other dangerous air pollution, with irreversible harm to public health and the environment, said Mark Brownstein, vice president of the Environmental Defense Fund.

"The oil and gas industry tell us natural gas is a clean, low-carbon fuel, but industry lobbyists and lawyers then argue to remove the protections necessary to deliver on that claim," he said, adding that the Trump administration appears "only too happy to throw common sense out the window" to serve corporate interests.
